Nutritionist -Ward 4

Iona is pleased to announce that we are hiring a Full-Time Ward 4, Nutritionist! This position is hybrid, with hours Monday to Friday, 9 AM - 5 PM. The hybrid schedule is dictated by the business needs of Iona with consideration of the employee's preferences

SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Ward 4 DACL Project Director, the Nutritionist will address the food and nutrition needs of older adults in Ward 4. They will provide oversight to congregate dining sites, provide nutrition counseling and facilitate nutrition education.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Congregate Dining Oversight

- Monitor food handling and sanitation procedures at sites.
- Provide general oversight of programs to include food and supply ordering, intakes and nutrition screening forms, compliance with Department of Aging and Community Living (DACL) grant standards, and evaluation of the programs.
- Perform Community Dining Site Manager functions when coverage is required.
- Provide additional support for community dining sites during special events or other situations requiring additional support.

Direct Services:

- Provide individual nutrition counseling to clients.
- Promote nutrition related events at dining sites by development or recruitment of special programs.
- Prepare and present monthly nutrition education and health presentations at Iona dining sites.

Programmatic Support:

- Collaborate with other Iona departments for purposes such as outreach, program delivery, communications, or any other aspects related to serving food insecure seniors in our service area.
- Participate in training and continuing education related to senior hunger and food insecurity.
- Perform on-site, in-person, and other community outreach and participate in communication and marketing efforts to identify seniors in need of food security assistance.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Licensed Dietitian or Nutritionist in the District of Columbia.
- Bachelor's degree in a relevant field, a Master's degree is preferred.
- Two years of relevant work experience, preferably working with older adults.
- ServSafe certification.
- Excellent organizational, communication (written and oral), customer service, data-management, problem solving, and cultural competency skills.
- Ability to problem-solve and use critical thinking skills.



- Strives to strengthen Iona's culture. Strives to assist CEO, Directors, and employees in achieving an equitable, diverse, and inclusive organization.
- Ability to work with older adults in underrepresented communities while demonstrating integrity, respect, resourcefulness, and empathy.
- Access to a car and valid driver's license for client home visits and deliveries or other on-site or community-based work.
- Ability to lift and carry food and supply items, as well as cases of DACL Nutrition Supplements, weighing up to 10-15 pounds as needed.
- A suitable home-based work environment to perform work duties without distraction and maintain lona confidential information in a secure manner.
- Passion for food and nutrition and for helping others.
- COVID19 vaccination required.
